

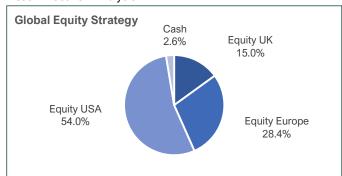
Strategy Description

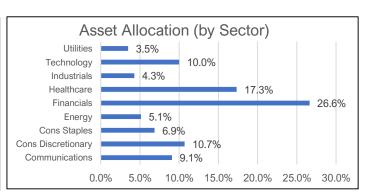
